Violation of Rule 3.12 “Licensees shall operate their establishments in such a manner as to avoid disturbing the peace, safety, health, quiet and general welfare of the community” (Re:

October 11, 2013, based on a 311 complaint, Liquor Board Inspector observed loud music coming from the establishment)

Violation of Article 2B Section 10-403(a)(1) (Re: May 1, 2013 to present) Petition signed by 119 citizens, residents, real estate owners and voters of the precinct in which establishment is situated
